What We Do

Guardians UK provide guardianship and related services to international boarding students. The services include host family arrangements, transfers to and from the airport, school visits and attendance at parents evenings, contact with parents, agents, schools and students.

Our main aim is to support our students while they are studying in the UK and to help parents with any request they may have to ensure that they feel confident their children are well cared for, content and thriving.

How We Do It

As well as the three members of the Guardians UK team, who act as guardians to all of our students, we have a large support network of host families, drivers and tutor companies who all work together so that students have the very best experience during their time in the UK.

Each member of the Guardians UK team are responsible for their own group of students, but in their absence any of the team will take over and look after the students and requests from parents and agents.

We have a large number of host families who accommodate students during half terms, exehats and longer holidays. They are also on hand to support us if any student is required to leave school due to illness or if their school requests that they be removed.

We have our own team of drivers used mainly for our students who travel as Unaccompanied Minors and long relationships with local taxi companies who drive students to and from the airport, host families etc.

All staff, host families and drivers are fully DBS checked before they start to work with students.

What We Believe In

We believe our role is to act as facilitators and advocates for our students while they are at school or during holidays when they are under our care whether they are with one of our host families or staying with friends or relatives or when they are travelling.

Safeguarding and child protection is foremost in everything we do and is our main guidance and consideration in any arrangements we make, conversations and contact we have with students and dealings we have with anyone who has contact with or is associated with our students.
